

Students who are scheduled to take Algebra I for the 2010-2011 school year should access the following web sites to solidify the specified mathematical concepts.

If your 8th grade math was Pre-Algebra, you should access:

www.math.com/practice/PreAlgebra.html . Please review all sub-headings provided. This web site has a four step online practice format. The web site also provides an 'in depth' tutorial for each concept. You should access this feature if you need additional explanation.

If your 8th grade math was Algebra:

www.purplemath.com. Go to the Lessons Index (right margin). Under Preliminary Topics, review all sub-headings. Also, under Solving Word Problems, review Translation, Age, Area/Volume/Perimeter, Distance, and Percent.

This summer assignment is a means to review and strengthen fundamental mathematical concepts so that you are prepared to enter Algebra I. There will be no formal testing of this material in September. However, the following is required:

- **Keep a log of the sites you visited and concepts you practiced. You will be asked to provide a written description of your summer preparation on the first day of Algebra I. This description should include amount of time spent on each concept.**
