

Studio II Summer Assignments:

There will be two assignments where original photos will be needed;

1. Theme: **Corners** -----David Hockney- style Cubist Photo Collage: Stand in front of an interesting corner: a place where things “happen”, with a variety of shapes, lines, textures , colors, etc. that have a unique appeal to you for this assignment. You may have people in it or not, animals, bugs all sorts of things may appear. There are all kinds of corners that would be great for this assignment : in your house, at a zoo, at a playground , a graveyard, a highway , your vacation place, swimming pool, work place, etc. Take at least **36 shots** of this scene without moving much(you can step forward or backward or bend your knees etc. to get variations) from the same spot . You may however, go back to the same spot over a span of days to get different lighting effects or incidental changes (new people or creatures, cars,etc) but always stand or squat or sit, etc. in basically the same spot to maintain the viewpoint. Print out your pictures before school starts. We will do the rest in class.

Google: **David Hockney photo collage** for examples. He was inspired by Picasso,among others and the idea that in a collage, any thing is possible!

2. We will be doing a painting based on a photo of something old and rusty or decaying –you may have to look in places that you don’t usually go but they are not hard to find in people’s back yards , garages, on the beach, near industrial areas, farm areas, etc.
