



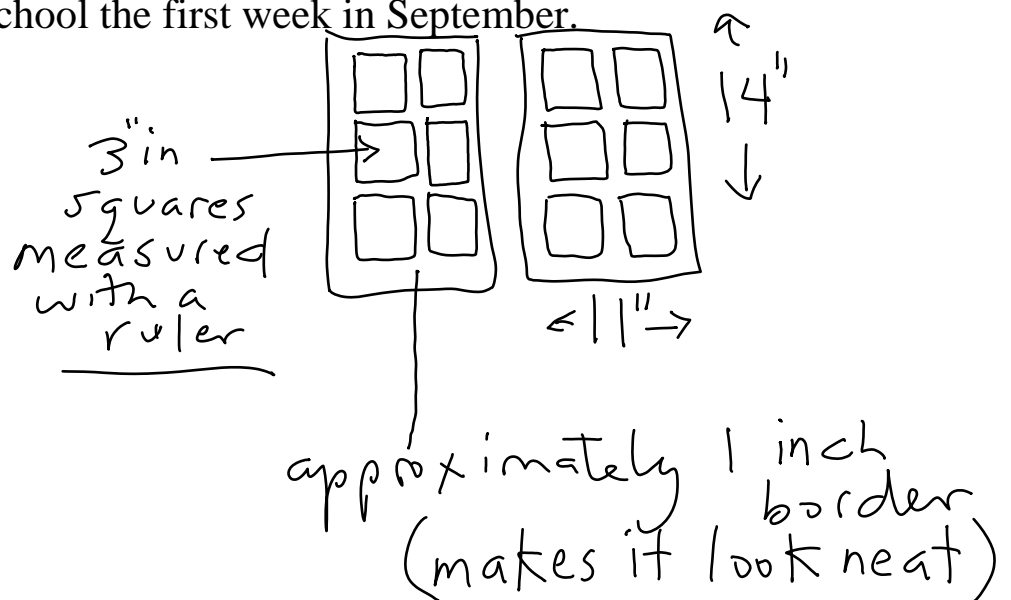
Summer Assignment for 2010

In the centers of two 11"x14" pieces of paper, draw six squares: Each should be 3"x 3" square and should be separated by a one inch margin so they do not touch each other or the edges of the paper. The boxes should be measured and drawn with a ruler or straight edge but you may soften or curve the corners if you like.

Find an interesting object (anything!: plant, animal, sculpture , found object, an industrially made thing like a car or piece of furniture) in whatever space you are in and you must draw that same object 12 different times in 12 different ways: you may use and or mix different drawing media (ink, crayon, pencil, etc.). Try to draw it from different angles and perspectives so that each box contains a unique look at or approach to the same subject. Bring your drawings to school the first week in September.
